Our staff holds both federal and state letters of authorization to conduct endangered species surveys for botanical and biological resources as well as section 10(a)(1)(A) recovery permit to survey for vernal pool invertebrates. Additionally we have an in-house International Society of Arboriculture certified arborist to conduct tree resource surveys and inventories.
